

WELCOME

Centreville, an 18th century Delaware Village listed in the National Register of Historic Places, is surrounded by superb country estates, world-renowned museums, and the beautiful Brandywine Valley. Winterthur Museum, Delaware Museum of Nature and Science, Burrows Run Preserve, Flint Woods, and Coverdale Farm are neighbors.

Brandywine Creek State Park, Longwood Gardens, Hagley Museum, Delaware Museum of Art, Brandywine Battlefield, and Brandywine River Museum are all within five miles of the Village proper.

A once-in-a-lifetime occasion to own 152 acres of pristine, unrestricted acreage in the heart of "Chateau Country."


The centerpiece of the Shadowbrook estate is the circa 1939 Georgian stone and frame home boasting approximately 12,000 sq. ft. of living space, 10 bedrooms, 10 bathrooms, 11 fireplaces and breathtaking views at every turn.



PINNACLE

Said to be the most beautiful property in Delaware, this breathtaking Centreville estate is set on 152 rolling acres, with fields and valleys that bridge the Delaware-Pennsylvania line. From a quiet road amid other properties with similar homes and acreage, the winding entrance drive follows the curves of the hills, leading upward to a great house whose setting protects privacy while maximizing views.



SOPHISTICATION

The Okie-style fieldstone façade with an expansive cobblestone parking court has a simpler entrance in keeping with the region's architectural vernacular.


ARRIVAL

The entrance drive slowly climbs the property's principal rise arriving at the home complete with paving stones in artful array around four original millstones, highly prized by local collectors.



ELEGANCE

Enter through the classic foyer graced by the light form of an elliptical stair, a replica of the Montmorenci Plantation stair which can now be found at Winterthur Museum.






The grand stair at Shadowbrook was modeled after the stair seen to the right.

DETAIL

Throughout all family living areas, millwork is creative and elaborate, and is considered to be of museum quality. The Louis XIV style fireplace ornamentation seen in the cloak room with crown moldings of repeating carvings is just one example.

ENTERTAIN


The central hall, located between the living and dining rooms, showcases ceiling-height shell-topped corner cabinets and an ingenious inlaid floor which creates the illusion of an octagon. This hall provides guests with their first glimpse of the exquisite outdoor views ahead.











BREAK BREAD


Host guests to your heart's content in the magnificent dining room. Like the other reception rooms, it offers space for the largest of gatherings while sharing the view of the pond and hills.

FROLIC




The billiards room is located directly below the sunroom with a lovely private bedroom complete with fireplace just steps away.

With a perfect commingling of old and new, Shadowbrook offers an endless array of interesting features at which to marvel.












NOURISH










MAIN LEVEL


FLOOR PLAN

SHADOWBROOK ADDITIONAL HIGHLIGHTS & FEATURES

- 152 acres of unrestricted property consisting of 4 tax parcels including main house, 5 rental dwellings, pool house, 2 horse barns and 3 sheds.
 - 16.87 acre | Main house, Tower house, pool & pool house,2 barns
 - 3.16 acre | Open land near the intersection of Old Kennett
 & Snuff Mill Rd
 - 119.08 acre | Farm acreage, pond, Gate house, Mill house (1206), Farmhouse/duplex

- Six recently installed geothermal systems (2017), heat is six zones, central air conditioning is five zones, high velocity for one zone resulting in low electric / utility bills.
- Ludowici ceramic tile roof.
- 400 AMP electrical service, house completely rewired in 1971.
- All asbestos insulation on heating pipes has been totally removed.
- Propane generator backup for geothermal systems, water heater, kitchen, and miscellaneous outlets.
- Museum quality millwork, moldings, stunning winding staircase, and fireplace mantels.

- Steady rental income from 5 dwellings, 1 of the horse barns, and farmland lease.
- Swimming pool with pool house two changing rooms each with shower and toilet.
- Stone carriage house (2525 sq. ft.) with parking for 7 cars. Second floor apartment with 2 bedrooms, 2 full baths, living room, dining room, kitchen, and sun porch.
- Stone and frame 2 story gate house, @ 1,440 sq. ft., 2 bedrooms, 1 full bath, living room, eat in kitchen, laundry in basement, oil heat, propane generator, well and septic.
- Stone Mill House @ 2,235 sq. ft. with 2 bedrooms, 2 full baths, kitchen, living room, family room, oil heat, air conditioning system that is high velocity, well and septic.
- Frame Farmhouse (duplex) with shingle siding @ 2,690 sq. ft. First unit has a living room, dining room, kitchen laundry room, 1 bedroom and one full bath. Second unit has a living room, eat in kitchen, 2 bedrooms, 1 full bath, laundry in basement, well and septic.
- Masonry barn @ 3,800 sq. ft. with 13 horse stalls, hay loft, bathroom, and tack room.
- Masonry barn @ 2,435 sq. ft. with 11 horse stalls, hay loft and tack room.
- Wood frame shed @ 1,056 sq. ft. with open bays.
- Wood frame equipment shed @ 1,728 sq. ft. with sliding doors.
- Pool house shed with double doors for pool supply storage, chemicals, and outdoor furniture.
- Family, equestrian, or country estate. Subdivision is an option. Current zoning is suburban estate (SE) which requires a 2-acre minimum lot.





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
